We welcome your input on the data TEA could provide to EPPs to help programs assess their impact, improve their design, and increase their effectiveness.

After engaging with stakeholders through the fall and winter of 2017, the feedback will be summarized and shared with the <u>State Board for Educator Certification</u> to inform future data collection and sharing.
