### Now Accepting Articles for the Texas Study of Secondary Education

**Submission deadlines: Fall publication October 1 - Spring publication February 1**

Manuscripts for the next issue of the Texas Study are due at the TASSP office in electronic format by the deadline. Articles will be peer-reviewed by the Texas Study Committee. Leti Menchaca, Director of Professional Development, is the Managing Editor of the Texas Study of Secondary Education.

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- ☞ TASSP is accepting articles that promote best practices, learning, leading, innovative programs, timely developments, and technology.
- ☞ The reading audience is comprised of over 6,000 school administrators and educational professionals. Campus administrators make up the largest body of the readership. Trainers, university personnel, and curriculum directors are also included in the subscription base.
- ☞ Articles must be **no more than ten pages in length**, double-spaced with 12-point type. All pages must be numbered, and references should be formatted in APA style. Articles **MUST** be submitted in electronic **Word format (DOC OR DOCX) ONLY!**  
We do not accept Google Docs.  
A brief author/s bio and author's mailing address should be included at the end of the article.
- ☞ An honorarium certificate valued at \$100 will be awarded to the lead authors of each elected article. The certificate may be used to defray the cost of either a TASSP membership or conference registration to the TASSP Summer Workshop or Fall Summit. Only one honorarium will be awarded per article. To qualify for membership, the author must meet the qualifications for either the TASSP active membership or associate membership.
- ☞ TASSP reserves the right to edit all manuscripts selected for publication in the *Texas Study of Secondary Education*.

**Deadline for submitting article for the Spring Publication: February 1**
