



## Revised Runoff Election dates

March 27, 2020

First of all, we want to give a great big thank you to Texas educators who are demonstrating their resilience and flexibility as they pivot to meet the needs of students in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. It is a challenging time for all of us and educators are revising lesson plans, virtually reaching out to students, and continuing to be role models for the over 5.4 million Texas public school students. Thank you for always thinking about the kids!

In response to the pandemic, the governor has issued two election related proclamations. One delays the Primary Runoff Elections from May 26<sup>th</sup> to July 14<sup>th</sup> and the other allows municipalities to postpone local elections scheduled for May 2<sup>nd</sup> until November. ### New Primary Runoff Dates:

Primary Runoff Elections - July 14, 2020

Last day to register to vote - June 15, 2020

Vote by mail application deadline – July 3, 2020

Early voting – July 6-10, 2020

**Election Day – July 14**
